HangMan® Gutter Light and Décor Clip Instructions

Attaches C7, C9, Mini Lights, Icicle Lights & LED Light Sets to Gutters!

IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Do not mount a cracked, frayed or damaged light set cord. Inspect cord periodically.
- This seasonal use product is not intended for permanent installation or use.
- Always unplug lights mounted with the Hangman when leaving the house, retiring for the night or if leaving them unattended.
- Do not use this product for other than its intended use.
- Do not hang ornaments or other objects from light cord.
- Do not close doors or windows on the light cord or extension cords as this may damage the wire insulation.
- Use Safety Glasses to prevent debris from entering eyes when working.
- Dress properly – do not wear loose clothing that hinders proper work safety.
- Follow all safety warnings and precautions listed on light set packaging.
- To avoid risk of electrical shock, unplug light string during installation.
- Do not install in a manner permitting damage to wire insulation. Use product with lights designed for outdoor use.
- Read and follow all instructions that are provided with this product.

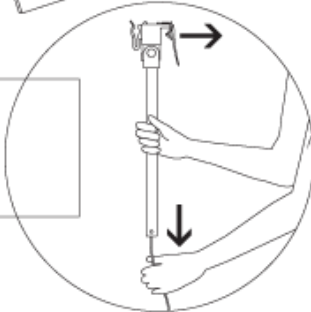
Installer Pole (3 pieces: 1 pole with installer head and cord attached, 1 middle pole, 1 lower pole)

25 Light Clips



STEP 1:

TO UNDERSTAND THE ACTION OF THIS CLIP, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CORD IS PULLED A FEW TIMES WHILE LOOKING AT THE CLIP END OF THE INSTALLATION SYSTEM. THIS WILL ALLOW A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE MOTION ON THE CLIP ARM.



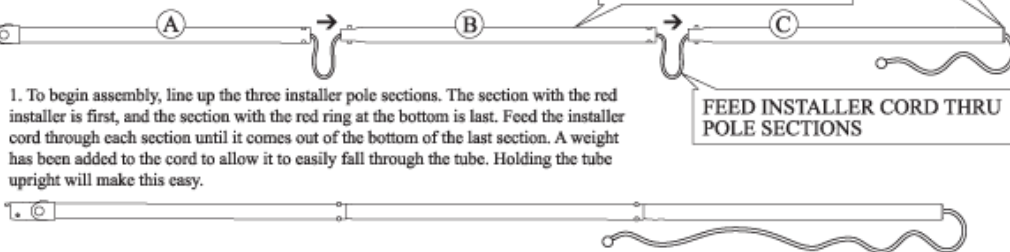
STEP 2: ASSEMBLY

Depending on how tall your gutter line is from the ground, you may use all three sections of the pole, or it may be easier to eliminate the center section on lower gutter lines for easier maneuverability of the pole. If a pole is removed, be sure it is the center pole. Removing the last pole will leave a sharp edge that could cut the cord.

RED RING

FEED INSTALLER CORD THRU POLE SECTIONS

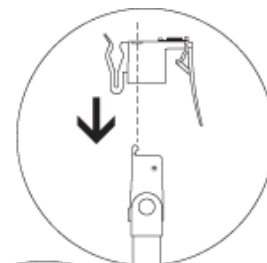


1. To begin assembly, line up the three installer pole sections. The section with the red installer is first, and the section with the red ring at the bottom is last. Feed the installer cord through each section until it comes out of the bottom of the last section. A weight has been added to the cord to allow it to easily fall through the tube. Holding the tube upright will make this easy.

2. Connect the sections of the installer pole together by lining up the snap buttons with the holes on the first piece, and snapping into place.

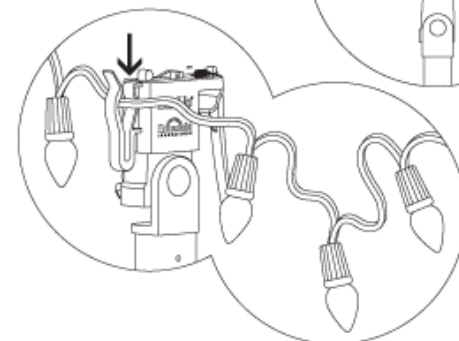
STEP 3: ATTACH CLIP TO INSTALLER

1. Once the installer is assembled, attach a clip to the installer head by lining up the opening on top of the clip with the upright tab on top of the installer head. Slide clip onto installer head until it clicks into place.



STEP 4: ATTACH STRING OF LIGHTS TO CLIP

1. Slide Light string wire into front wire holder on clip

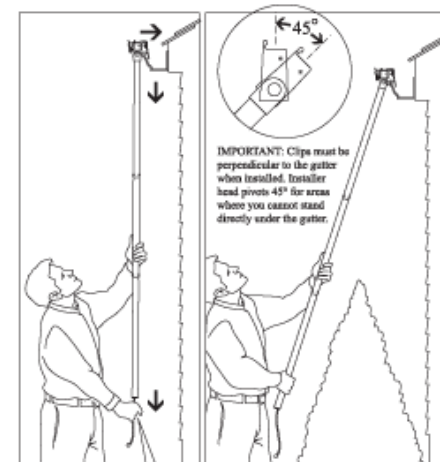


STEP 5: ATTACH CLIP TO GUTTER

1. Use the installer to reach the clip to the gutter with the clip facing outward. Pull down on the installer cord to extend the back of the clip to fit over the gutter lip.
2. Release the cord to snap the clip into place on the gutter.
3. Pull down on the installer to release the clip. (Be sure not to pull on the cord at this time)

Repeat steps 3 through 5 moving along the house to install each clip.

For best results, install 1 clip for every 6 ft. of gutter.



IMPORTANT: Clips must be perpendicular to the gutter when installed. Installer head pivots 45° for areas where you cannot stand directly under the gutter.

PULL INSTALLER CORD, ATTACH CLIP TO GUTTER, RELEASE CORD AND PULL DOWN TO RELEASE CLIP FROM INSTALLER HEAD

STEP 6: REMOVING THE CLIP

1. At the end of the season, remove each clip and save for next year's use. Slip the installer head into the bottom opening of the clip. Pull down on the installer cord to disengage the back of the clip. Push upward to remove the clip from the gutter.
